



Cornwall - Mystery and history

One of the best sections of this coast path follows the rugged cliffs, sheltered coves and beaches of the Lizard and is the core theme of this break. With wonderful views across Mount Bay and a glorious variety of wild flowers and seabirds, these walks are full of interest and spectacular scenery. They also take you inland through special marshland habitats and onto the ancient Goonhilly Downs while your base in Mullion has a beach nearby.

2 days, 1 night

Walk 1 - Arrive and check in, then a steady ascent takes you onto the Predannack Downs. You'll cross farmland from here towards the Goonhilly Downs dotted with standing stones and burial mounds. The area covered is all part of a National Nature Reserve with rare plants and wildlife.

Walk 2 - A gently undulating walk that takes you across farmland to the coast at Gunwalloe. Halzephron cliff provides stunning views before you follow the coast path back to Mullion.

Walk 3 - Today you will follow the coast around Britain's most southerly point. You'll see local landmarks such as the Lion's Den and the Lizard lighthouse as well as enjoying the natural erosional features created by the sea. A gentle walk with stunning scenery.
